


Procedure to be followed by Applicant for E-Waste EPR Registration through CPCBE - Waste EPR Portal

1. The Applicant shall visit E- Waste Management System Portal. The link is given below, [E-Waste Management System \(ewastecpcb.in\)](http://ewastecpcb.in)
2. The link will direct the applicant to the Home page of E-Waste EPR Portal.



EPR Portal for E-Waste Management

Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) of producers are regulated through grant of Registration Certificate and issue Recycling Targets / EPR obligation. For Registration Certificate and Recycling Targets / EPR Obligation producers under these Rules (definition given below) are required to apply on the EPR Portal at the URL ewastecpcb.in to CPCB. This E-Waste EPR Portal is an online E-Waste Management System, where applicant producers can apply online for grant of Registration Certificate and Recycling Targets / EPR obligation. All the stakeholders like Producer, Recyclers, Refurbishers and Manufacturers are required to register themselves on this system. The CPCB shall generate Extended Producer Responsibility Registration Certificate of Producers through the portal in favour of a Producer on receiving the required information on the portal as per the SOP. The producer shall fulfill their extended producer responsibility through online purchase of extended producer responsibility certificate from registered recyclers only and have to submit it online by filing quarterly return. 'Producer' means

The EPR Portal has been developed based on the provisions of the E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2022.
